Caramês Full Arch Clinical Experiences - Regeneration







COURSE OVERVIEW

The rehabilitation of edentulous jaws with immediate loading of osseointegrated implants has been proven to be a predictable treatment over time. The Caramês classification was designed to enable personalized treatment of edentulous patients, considering each individuals expectations, clinical situation, and financial capabilities. Patient-specific treatment protocols are based on the vast experience and anatomic classification developed by Prof. João Caramês, who hosts the course. Treatment planning, from analogical to digital and decision-making strategies that need to be considered with be covered. This course will focus on bone augmentation strategies to solve full arch cases from simple to complex situations, without forgetting several factors such as patient selection, implant distribution, number of implants and soft tissue management.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

The learning objective of the course is to provide theoretical training and practical experience to successfully manage clinical cases with bone augmentation techniques and immediate loading treatments according to the Caramês Classification surgical and restorative protocol. The program will include discussions about bone regeneration techniques from Guided Bone Regeneration to L-PRF techniques, the importance of grafting and the lip support, sinus augmentation. Modern technologies, surgical and prosthetic techniques, same day immediate loading, clinical evidence in the field of immediate full arch restorations will also and maintenance protocols will also be discussed. The team of experts from the Implantology Institute® will lead the conversations and will answer the questions. The course will take place for one day and a half with theoretical lectures and live surgeries.









